LIST OF ITEMS NEEDED

- Paints - blue, purple, orange, green, yellow, white (we used Kmart 8 pack acrylic paint - bright for \$5.50)
- Paint pen - some girls added this other didn't worry with the black outline
- canvasses, gyprock, card, or other (We purchased Canvasses from Kmart 12" x 16" anko stretched canvas - 2 for \$5.00)
- Tape - for the steps - this is pulled off after painting the sky
- Paint trays and brushes, various sizes
- water containers
- Easels (I'm working on a prototype made from Aldi milk boxes)
- Paintbrushes - thin, wide, some girls found the paint sponges better - whatever works for you.



The video will give you the instructions to follow. There are instructions at the beginning for an easel made out of a box. Some of our girls found the easel good others got rid of it. There also instructions about using tape to create the steps.

Tips: The paint took longer to dry than expected so have a hairdryer or heater available to dry the paint between layers.
